# On farm classroom at Frogmary Green Farm in South Petherton is nominated for prestigious planning industry award

An innovative farm classroom, the S.H.E.D (Schools' Health and Educational Den) at Frogmary Green Farm in South Petherton is a finalist in the category for Excellence in Planning for Health and Wellbeing at the Royal Town Planning Institute's (RTPI) <u>Awards for</u> <u>Planning Excellence 2018</u>. The RTPI Awards are the most established and respected awards in the UK planning industry. Running for over 40 years, they celebrate exceptional examples of planning and the contribution planners make to society.

An award winning arable and poultry farm at South Petherton in South Somerset run by Nick and Claire Bragg has brought the classroom to the countryside in conjunction with Somerset Public Health giving children a hands-on 'Field to Fork' experience of the links between food production, cooking and healthy eating and how farming cares for the environment.
